

Work Session  
Thursday, October 6, 2011

The North Iowa Community School Board of Education met in a work session on Thursday, October 6, 2011, in the Family Consumer Science Classroom. The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Pres. Giesking with members Balvance, Duve, Giesking, Holstad, Rygh, and Sachs answering roll call. Also in attendance were Supt. Myer, MS/HS Prin. Embrock, Sec. Meinders, Andy Buffington representing the Winnebago County Emergency Management, Laurel Clement representing the North Iowa Area Council of Governments (NIACOG), and Brian Blodgett.

Balvance moved, Duve seconded to approve the agenda. Ayes: 6. Carried.

Laurel Clement, Disaster Recovery Coordinator for NIACOG began with introductions of all members present and stated the purpose of the workshop as a planning meeting for the Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan for Winnebago County. Members then assisted Clement in identifying the hazards specific to the North Iowa Community School District and scoring their probabilities, magnitude, warning time, and duration. Mr. Myer and Clement will work together to identify the district's critical facilities at a later date. Once the most prominent hazards were identified, members selected mitigation measures noting how each hazard could be improved to lessen the impact to the district.
